WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?



Be an **Indiana resident** and a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen



Have a high school diploma or equivalency diploma/GED but less than a college degree



Enroll in a qualifying certificate program at an eligible training provider



File the FAFSA
(Free Application for
Federal Student Aid)



Independent students:

- must enroll at least half time for federal financial aid (typically two courses)
- must be meeting SAP or have not attended for two years



Dependent students:

- must enroll full time for federal financial aid (typically four courses)
- must currently be meeting SAP

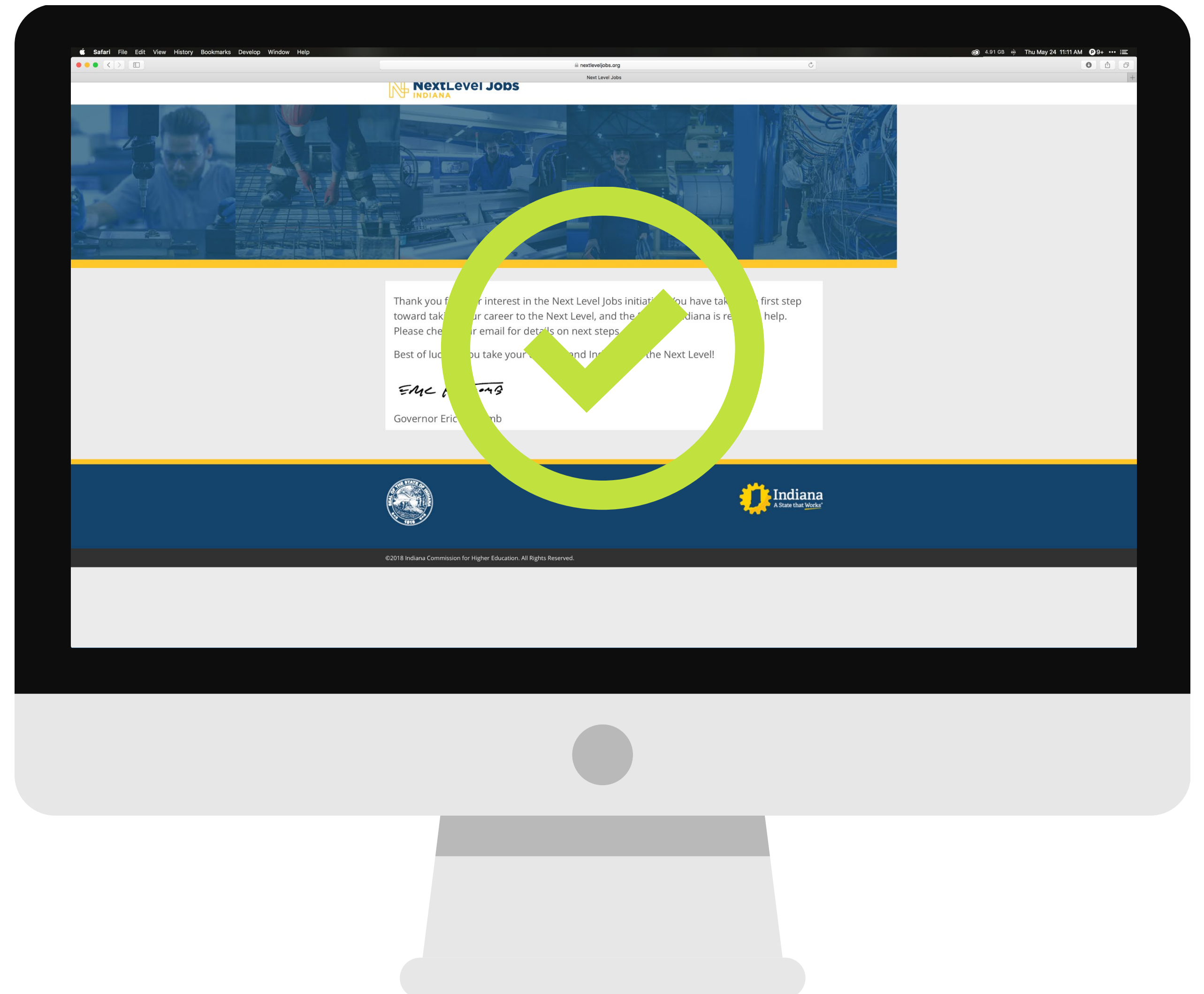
