New Program Highlights:

Centerstone's Stride Center Crisis Receiving & Stabilization Services: opened in April 2023 serving Bartholomew, Decatur, Jackson, Jennings and Johnson Counties for individuals in crisis, providing a safe space, open 24/7, as an alternative to jail or emergency departments. DMHA funds were received in 2023 to support both Columbus and Bloomington Stride Centers.

3. Depressive Disorders

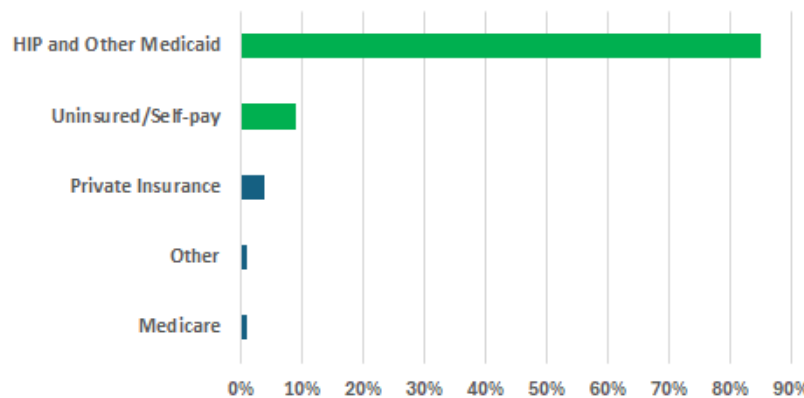
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
