- INcompass Healthcare was awarded Crisis Stabilization Grant and began providing services through Mobile Crisis, with the Crisis Care Center (CCC) opening in April 2024.

3. Generalized Anxiety Disorder

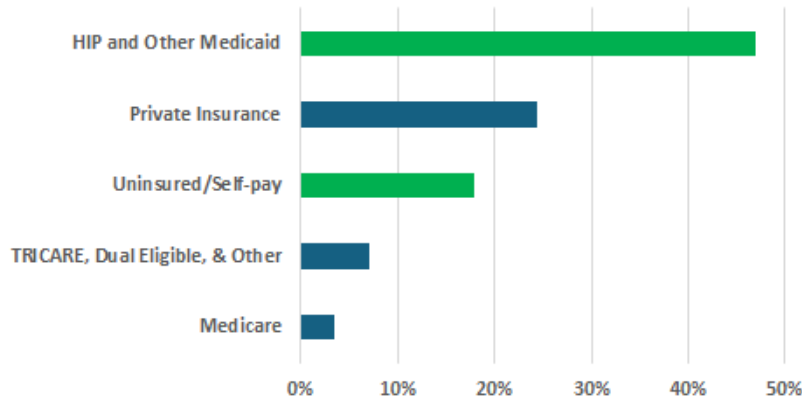
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
