3. Major depressive disorder, recurrent, moderate

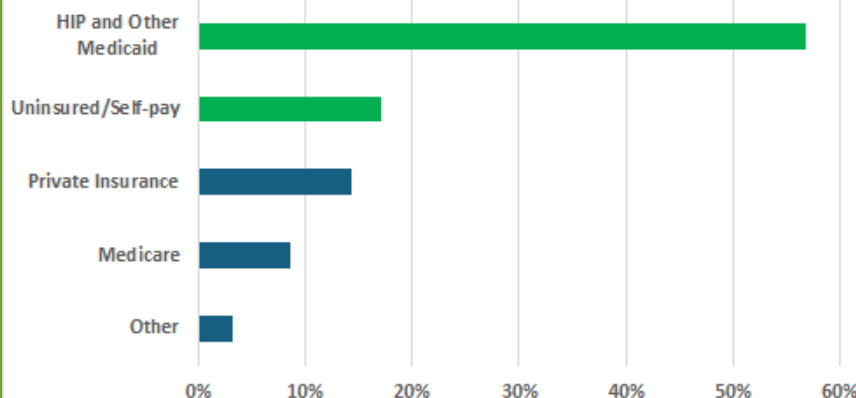
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
