3. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder

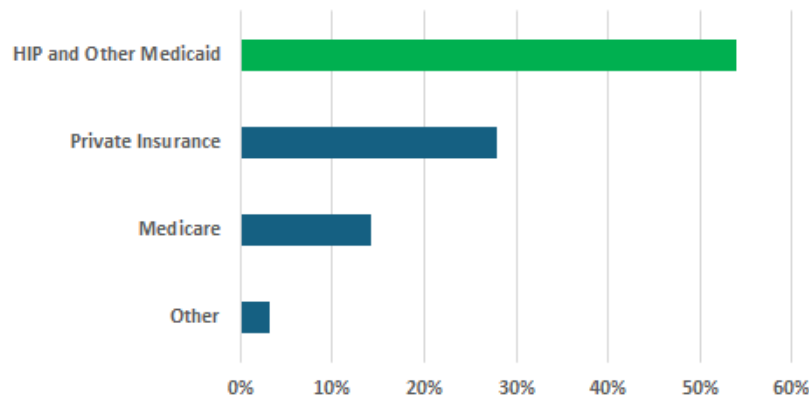
Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:
