New Program and Partnership Highlights:

- Entered the Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) demonstration in January 2025
- Expanded services within the crisis center (opened April 2024), strengthened mobile crisis services and the full crisis continuum, collectively serving 193 youth and 1,121 adults
- Dedicated veteran care coordinator program was launched to better support veterans in need of mental health and substance use treatment
