## New Program Highlights:

- Transitioned to a Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) model, expanding Same Day Access, onsite intakes at probation and jail, evening and weekend hours, and embedding peers into care teams
- Crisis services are fully functional with daytime office support, 24/7 Mobile Crisis Response Teams, and the STRIDE Regional Crisis Diversion Center offering walk-in assessments & resources
