Top 3 Primary Diagnoses - Adults:

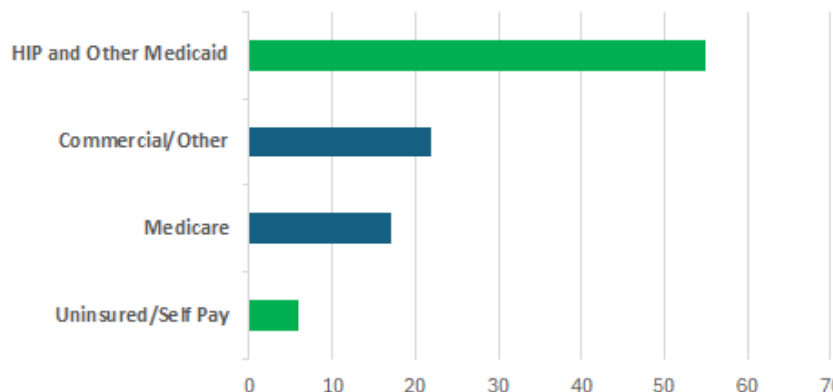
1. Major Depressive Disorder, Recurrent, Severe without Psychotic Features
