3. Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder, Unspecified

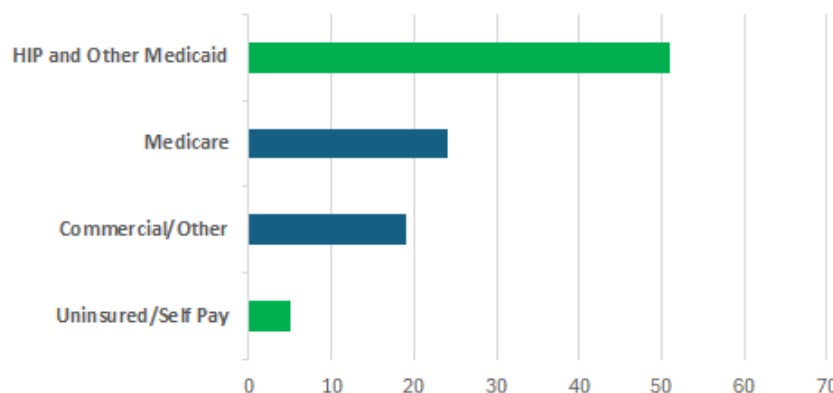
