

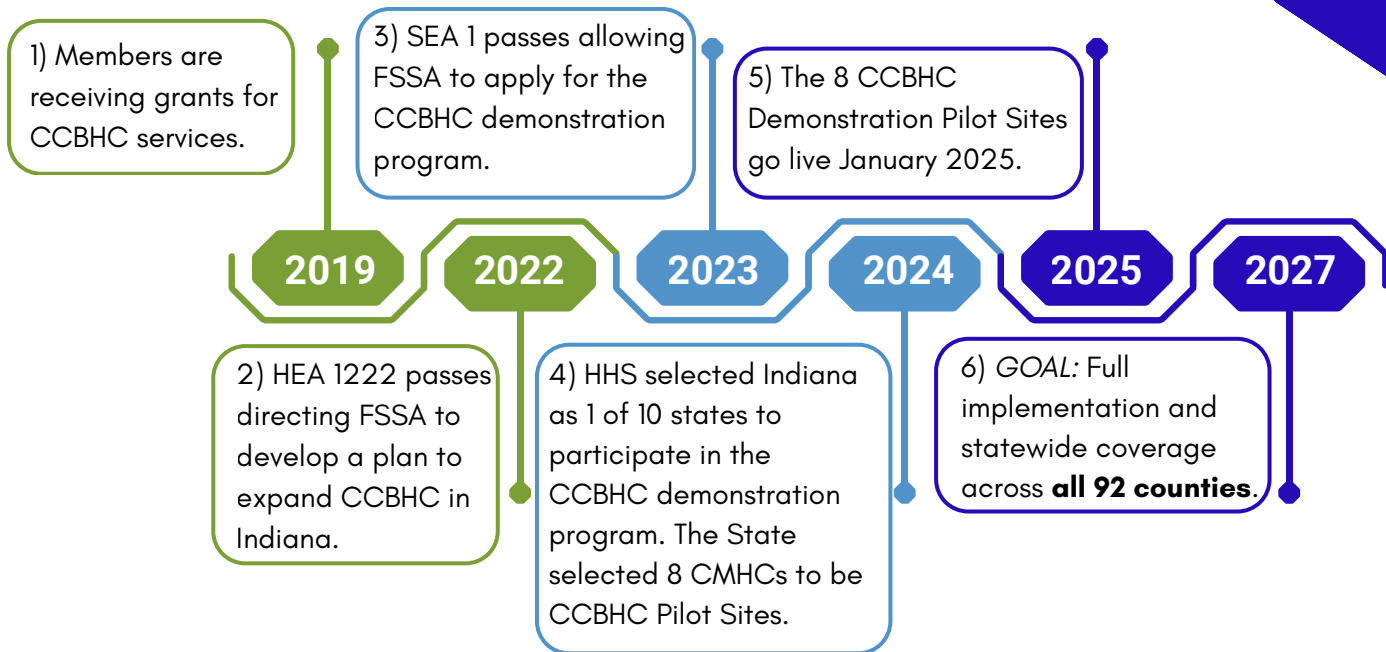
2027 LEGISLATIVE AGENDA

TRANSFORMING THE MENTAL HEALTH SAFETY NET SYSTEM

Indiana's Community Mental Health Centers (CMHCs) have long been the backbone of our behavioral health system, but the current braided funding structure makes it difficult to respond flexibly to the needs of the people and communities we serve. The Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) model provides an opportunity to build a more responsive, sustainable system—one grounded in Indiana's vision of ***Someone to Call, Someone to Respond, and Somewhere to Go***. CCBHCs allow providers to meet people where they are, whether that means responding to a crisis in the community, connecting someone to care outside of traditional clinic walls, or providing comprehensive services under one coordinated system. Unlike a funding structure that can tie resources to individual services, the CCBHC model provides greater flexibility to invest in the workforce, services, and community-based supports needed to meet local needs. This is about moving from a system that asks people to fit into the services available to one that has the ability to meet people where they are.



HOW WE GOT HERE

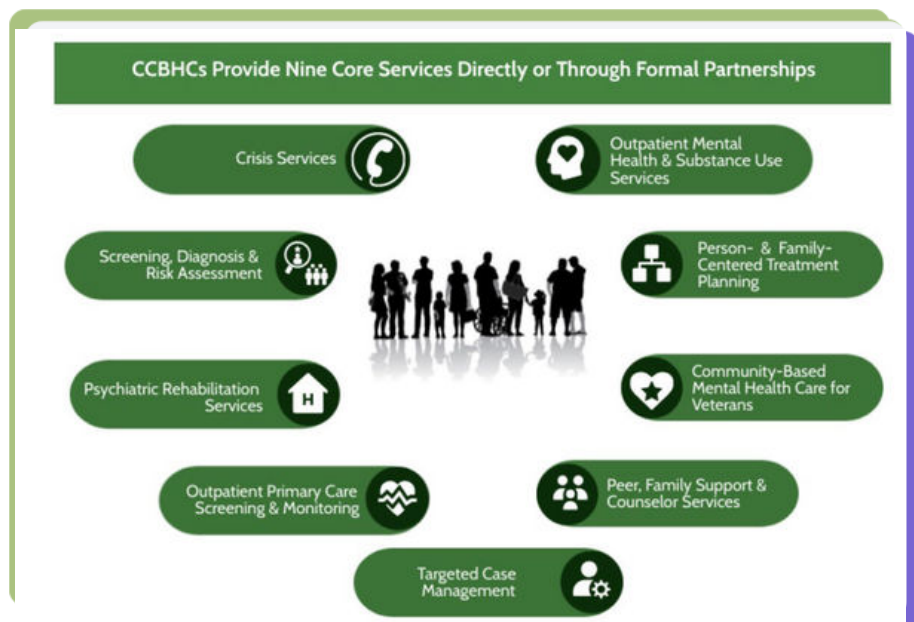


Where we're going... is to begin the process for a state plan amendment to make the CCBHC program permanent for when the demonstration ends in 2028.

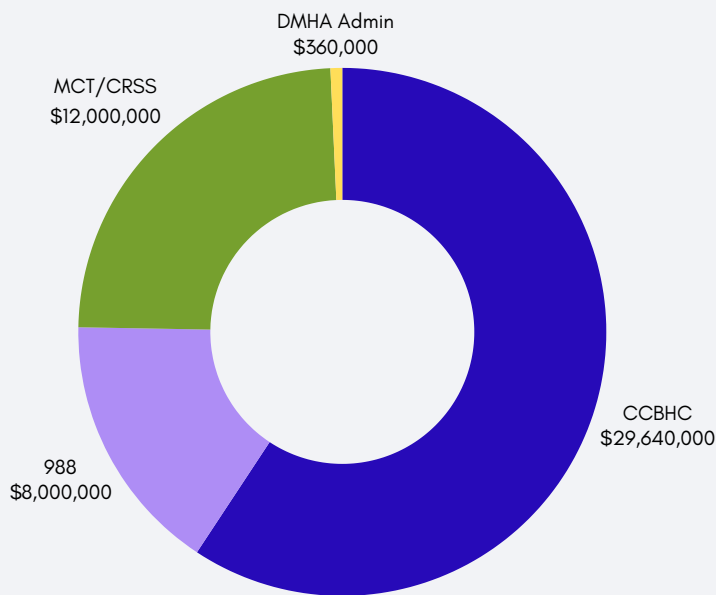
WHAT IS CCBHC?

A Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) is a federal model that allows for flexible funding for current outpatient mental health services. This new approach will provide the structure and financing needed to transform local communities' access to services. There are 9 core required services for CCBHC, including **crisis services**. This model allows providers to treat individuals in lower-cost settings by intervening early and diverting them from more costly settings, such as jails or hospitals.

Through CCBHC, providers are also able to keep individuals in their communities and create local provider partnerships. There are currently **8 demonstration sites** in Indiana, covering roughly **39 counties**.

COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH FUND (see chart)

Almost every dollar that has been appropriated through the Community Mental Health Fund, since 2023, is being used for services. To the left is a breakdown of the spend for state fiscal year (SFY) 2027. The continuation of these funds will help ensure the continuation of vital services and sustainability as we build out the statewide CCBHC system.

CCBHC BRAIDED FUNDING

The current funding for the CCBHC program is:

- Community Mental Health Fund
- Existing CMHC Contracts
- Medicaid Rehabilitation Option (MRO) Contracts
- Enhanced Federal Match
- Outpatient Services Medicaid Billing

\$4M per month in federal funding (\$165M for remainder of the demonstration CY2026–2028) is lost until coverage expands to all 92 counties.

GROUP HOMES ROOM & BOARD

Group homes primarily serve the seriously mentally ill (SMI) population, this includes those diagnosed with schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, post-traumatic stress disorder, etc. As the SMI population ages, the current funding structure for group homes is not sustainable. We are advocating for a standard room and board rate for group homes. This room and board payment is already done in other settings, such as with substance use disorder residential treatment and intellectually and developmentally disabled group homes. Additionally, without a more reliable funding source there is a risk of beds closing, leaving longer wait times for the SMI within our State Hospital system.

This group home room and board rate will allow providers to have a stable and simplified funding source to care for the behavioral health needs of this unique population and ensure that beds can remain open for future patients.
